

SIZING CHART

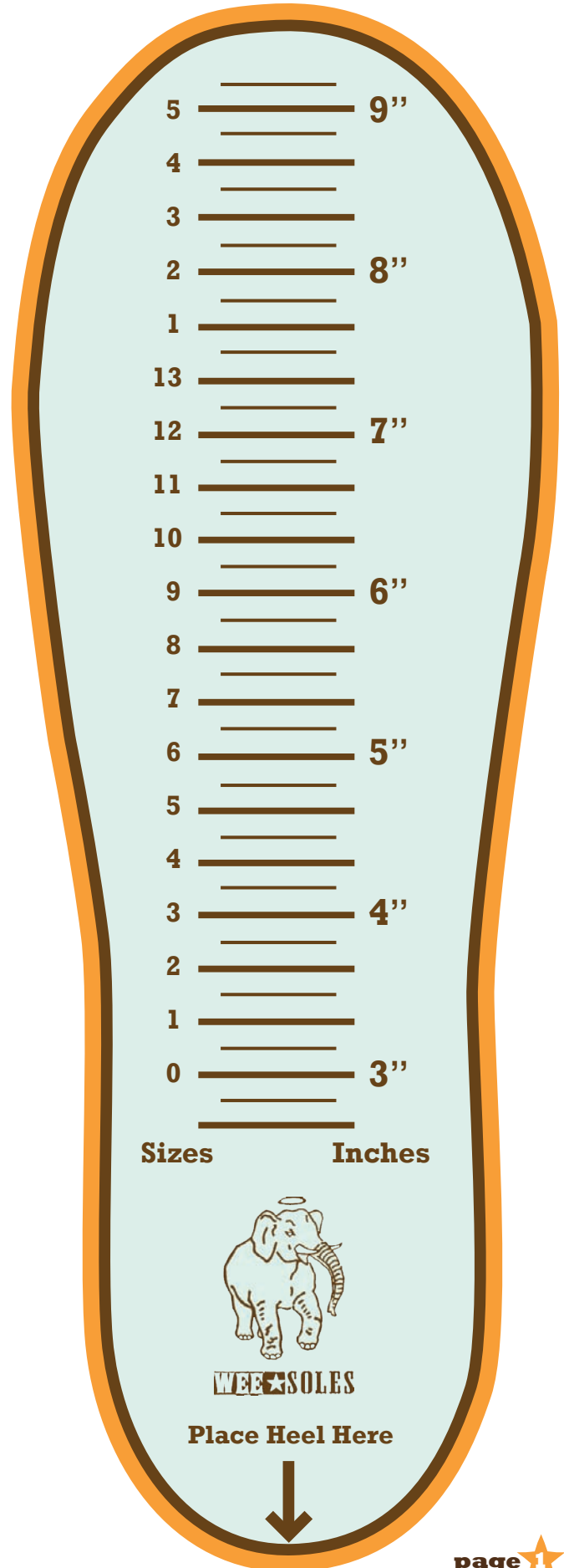
& Instructions



- ★ Print this page out to best measure your child's shoe size.
- ★ Place the paper on a hard surfaced floor and have your child stand on foot measure.
- ★ Follow the line across to the shoe size.
- ★ Measure both feet. Use measurement of larger foot, if one foot is larger than the other (very common).
- ★ To measure the foot's width, mark two dots where the widest points of the foot are. When the foot is off the paper, draw a line between the two dots and use a ruler to determine how many inches. Reduce this number by 1/5-inch. The result is the number you will use to determine your foot width.
 - 1-2 inches is Narrow (A, B)
 - 2-3 inches= Medium (C, D)
 - 3-4 inches= Medium to Wide (D, E)
 - 4+ inches= Wide to Double Wide (E, EE)
- ★ If needed, convert these US sizes into European sizes by using the [chart on page 2](#).

Buying Tips

- ★ **MEASURE REGULARLY**
Children's feet grow in spurts. Toddler's need to be measured every 2-3 months and school age every 4-6 months.
length: there should be about 1 cm (a thumbs width) between the longest toe and end of shoe.
width: you should be able to 'pinch' the top of the shoe:
depth: there should be plenty of wiggle room between the toes and the top of the shoe.
- ★ **ARCH SUPPORT:**
Children's arches do not develop fully until 6-8 yrs. Most children do not need a special arch support.
- ★ **BUYING FOR THE FIRST WALKER/TODDLER:**
Most children learn to walk around 12 months of age. Once they begin walking on their own they need shoes.
For first walkers and toddlers you need a light shoe with a flexible, flat sole.
- ★ **BUYING FOR SCHOOL-AGE:**
Look for a shoe that is flexible in the sole, well ventilated and comfortable to the child.
